Organising Authority

The organizing authority is Fishers Green Sailing Club

The venue shall be Fishers Green Sailing Club, Holyfield Lake, Waltham Abbey, Essex, EN9 2EG

Rules

All races will be governed by the current World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the RYA, the relevant Class Rules, the Fishers Green Sailing Club Sailing Instructions and any Special Event Sailing Instructions.

The Sailing Instructions and any Special Event Sailing Instructions will be available at Fishers Green Sailing Club before and during the Open Meeting.

Scoring

The series will be scored as provided in Appendix A of the RRS using the Low Point System. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series for the event. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her individual race scores. When four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Equipment

Competitors must ensure their craft comply with relevant Class Association rules. For this event Competitors may use their choice of ILCA Class approved sails or equivalent reproduction items.

Entries

Entries and entrance fee (£15 single hander or £20 double hander, per boat) must be received online by 19:00hrs two days prior to the event or on the appropriate paper entry form at least 30 minutes before the start of the first race.

Any boat entering must have valid Third Party insurance cover for a minimum of £3,000,000

Liability

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

(i) they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;

(ii) they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;

(iii) they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;

(iv) their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

(v) the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

(vi) the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

(vii) it is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue;

Parents and guardians are warned that they have sole responsibility for their children and wards and must appreciate that Fishers Green Sailing Club CIC cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control. Fishers Green Sailing Club cannot accept responsibility for children, or any other persons not engaged in racing.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organisers according to the number of entries.
